Pegasus Residential Trip to Shortenills - 14 to 16 May 2018

The weather looks like it will be warm and dry - let's hope the forecast does not change too much!

As Shortenills is very near we have saved costs by not booking a coach. Children should arrive at Shortenills (Nightingales Lane, Chalfont St Giles, HP8 4SG) at 9.30am on Monday, 14 May 2018.

During the three days the children will be completing the following activities: Monday - discovering Shortenills, orienteering, Anglo Saxon stories and riddles Tuesday – Anglo Saxon activities, food and feast foraging, history detectives Wednesday - wild woods learning, shelter building

Please pack small games and puzzles for the evening and self led times. However, mobile phones and electronic devices are not allowed.

All medical forms and contact details will be kept by myself, together with a supply of Calpol and Neurofen with the school First Aid kit. All other medicines must be clearly marked in a plastic bag and handed to me on arrival.
