With the snow forecast and the prediction of cold weather next week please can all keyworker parents of children who will be in school ensure your child comes to school in warm clothing.

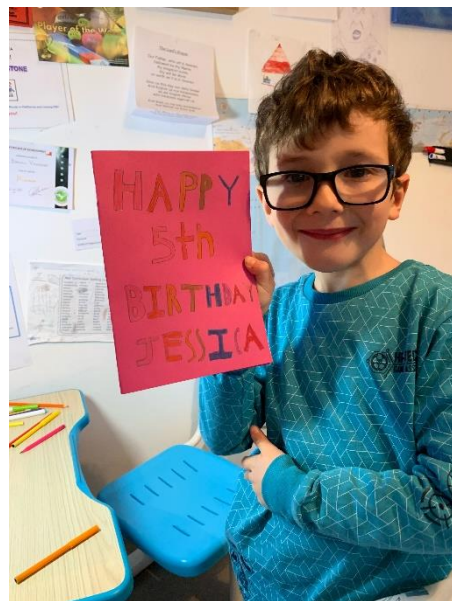
